Mr Reginald Jokhan is the company Managing Director of Jokhan Realtors Pte Ltd, a local real estate company. He started the company in year 2000 singlehandedly and the company has grown to over 30 staff. The company extends to the West of Fiji and has representation in all major towns.

Jokhan Realtors Pte Limited was one of the first companies in Fiji to offer Property Management Services at an International Level. The Company manages over 150 properties with over 300 tenants on behalf of local and overseas property owners.

Mr Jokhan joined the Fiji Military Forces as a Private in 1987.

He has been a Martial Arts Chief Instructor in Fiji for over 30 years. He took part in several national and international championships and won a silver medal in the Heavyweight division in Fiji and a silver medal in the heavyweight division in the South Pacific Tournament in 1985 in New Zealand.

Mr Jokhan is a trained Technician for Treating Divers with Bends syndrome and worked as a bends technician for six years. He comes with extensive experience and knowledge not only in the real estate industry but is a successful businessman and entrepreneur.
